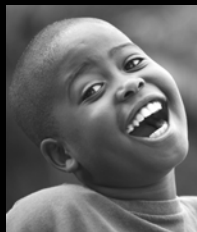

## GIVING FROM WITHIN

**Board of Directors Giving.** The work being done at Tennyson Center for Children wouldn't be possible without the guidance and support of our respected Board of Directors. In fiscal 2008, their collective financial support of the agency brought in a total of \$448,212.

**Employee Giving.** The staff at Tennyson Center for Children shows their commitment to the kids we serve every day not only with their dedicated work, but also with their financial support. During fiscal year '08, we received \$65,782 in employee donations.

**Residential.** Our programming continues to be flexible and individualized for the child's specific needs, while attending to decreased lengths of stays in order to successfully return the youth back to the community setting as soon as possible. The four cottages, including Stepping Stones, a short-term adolescent treatment program, ran comprehensive programming addressing the needs of youth in the arenas of therapy, education, health, recreation, experiential learning, spiritual growth, social skill development and healthy relationships. Census increased during the last quarter, with referral requests ranging from statewide counties, mental health agencies, and private referrals. Additionally, we embarked on an exciting research project with The Colorado Association of Family and Children's Agencies (CAFCA) to develop outcome measures that will evaluate the progress which youth experience in residential care over time.

**Education Services and Day Treatment.** Our on-campus school and day treatment programming remains strong and active with high census and creative teachers! Denver Public School District continues to place students directly in the IDEAL program, a specialized education program to assist in the return to a public school setting. Our expansion to the secondary education program is in full force, offering education to our Stepping Stones residential and Day Treatment youth. Tennyson Center's school program is a leader in transitioning youth back into their communities.

**School-Based Education Services.** Our successful partnership with local school districts is evident at our Littleton Day Treatment program at Hopkins Elementary School in Littleton, servicing three school districts. Our Public School Support Specialist provides behavioral support and intervention within the Douglas County School District. This unique partnership allows increased therapeutic and behavioral services to students which lead to increased student success and prevention of out-of-district placement.

**Home-Based and Community-Based Programs.** Child welfare research suggests that the greatest outcomes occur when working with families in their natural environment and Tennyson Center has taken the lead in this arena! Our community-based team continues to work with the clients in the home and community environments, addressing daily life issues while teaching families the skills for self-sufficiency. This unique service within our continuum of care assists with prevention of family disruption and out-of-home placements.

**Office of Strategic Initiatives/Every Child Matters .** TCC was pleased to open a new division in 2008 in the Office of Strategic Initiatives (OSI), which focuses on government relations, public policy, civic engagement, and strategic collaborations that work to promote opportunity and improve outcomes for vulnerable children and families. OSI represents TCC in local, state, and federal legislative affairs. Additionally, OSI contracts for research, public education, and advocacy projects. OSI also hosts and directs the Colorado Office of the national Every Child Matters Campaign.

**Positive Behavior Support.** The national model of Positive Behavior Support (PBS) is a "broad range of systemic and individualized strategies for achieving important social and learning outcomes while preventing problem behavior" (PBS Manual, Sugai and Horner, September, 2005). The Tennyson staff and our PBS Committee have fully engaged this evidence-based practice within the school system. The success is evident and will be tracked in 2009 via PBS' tracking program, SWIS. Monthly school assemblies celebrate the youths' progress and achievement.

**Experiential Learning.** Experiential learning is woven into many aspects of Tennyson's services for youth and families. The 2008 Summer Program, Challenge By Choice, offered up to ten youth an intense summer program designed to help them realize emotional and physical growth through hiking, outdoor wilderness activities and camping. As always, the 2008 program culminated with the participants, accompanied by staff, climbing to the summit of Mt. Elbert.



## THE YEAR IN REVIEW

During the calendar year of 2008, we serviced 372 children and nearly 1,500 family members in our programs. The continued challenge of Federal funding cuts impacted utilization of residential services statewide. However, Tennyson's focus on improved management of service utilization in addition to expansion of community-based care has opened doors for access of services in tight budgetary times. TCC embarked on full implementation of our enhanced management information system, providing expanded client information tracking, outcomes review and data management. And of course 2008 demonstrated another year of committed staff and dedication to TCC's mission.



**Volunteers.** We were privileged to have more than 1,000 volunteers help us fulfill our mission. Those dedicated individuals gave nearly 20,000 hours of service in a variety of capacities. Without our family of volunteers, we would be unable to fulfill our mission.

**Golf Tournament.** The 2008 annual golf tournament was our most successful ever. Held at the beautiful Sanctuary, the tournament drew 120 participants and raised \$377,000. The pre-tournament dinner at Fleming's Prime Steakhouse was once again the perfect way to kick off this incredible event in support of the children we serve.

**Operation Santa.** Tennyson Center's Operation Santa program has become one of Denver's favorite holiday charitable events. Our supporters once again helped to make the holiday season much brighter for children and families served by Tennyson Center. By fulfilling wish lists for the children, our programs, classrooms, and cottages as well as families we serve, nearly \$90,000 was raised in both cash donations as well as gifts-in-kind.

**Regional Dinners.** Supporters once again showed up in droves for all three of our annual, regional fundraising dinners. The Denver Dinner, held at the Korbel Ballroom of the Colorado Convention Center, The Northern Colorado Dinner at the Marriott Ft. Collins, and the Colorado Springs Dinner, held at The Cheyenne Mountain Resort collectively raised \$592,291. Thanks to everyone who helped make those events such successes.

**Major Gifts.** Gifts from individuals reached just shy of \$1,000,000 last year. Of that amount, \$500,000 was pledged as an endowment challenge. This challenge gift will match outright gifts made to TCC's endowment over the next five years, up to a total of \$500,000. Our goal is to provide ongoing services for at-risk children for decades to come through building a solid financial base.

**Web Giving.** Our websites at [childabuse.org](http://childabuse.org) and [tennysoncenter.org](http://tennysoncenter.org) once again drew a record number of visitors from around the world, averaging 1.2 million hits per month. Among child abuse websites worldwide, the Tennyson Center website consistently averaged in the top three search results on Google and in the top five on MSN. Visitors who donated online via the website gave a total of \$38,400 in fiscal year 2008.

**Direct Mail.** Direct mail has long been a staple of the Tennyson Center Development efforts, but fiscal 2008 brought us our most successful efforts yet. For the first time in the history of the agency, our direct mail campaigns raised over \$400,000.

**Corporate Support.** We continue to increase our corporate partnerships with companies throughout Colorado who understand the value of giving back to the community. Whether through an employee driven fundraiser or a sponsorship contribution, Colorado companies showed their support of Tennyson Center for Children by donating more than \$552,000 in fiscal 2008. We are grateful for the generosity shown by these companies and we look forward to developing new partnerships as well.

**Foundation Support.** Tennyson Center received over \$360,000 in grants and gifts from private, community and family foundations supporting general operations, programs and special projects.



### IT TAKES THE ENTIRE COMMUNITY

We've all heard the saying, "It takes a village to raise a child." By the same token, it takes the entire community to help us fulfill our mission of service to children and families. From our volunteers who give of their time and their hearts to our generous donors who give their financial and gift-in-kind support, our successes are the result of a community-wide effort. In fiscal 2008, our community helped us raise a record \$3.4 million.

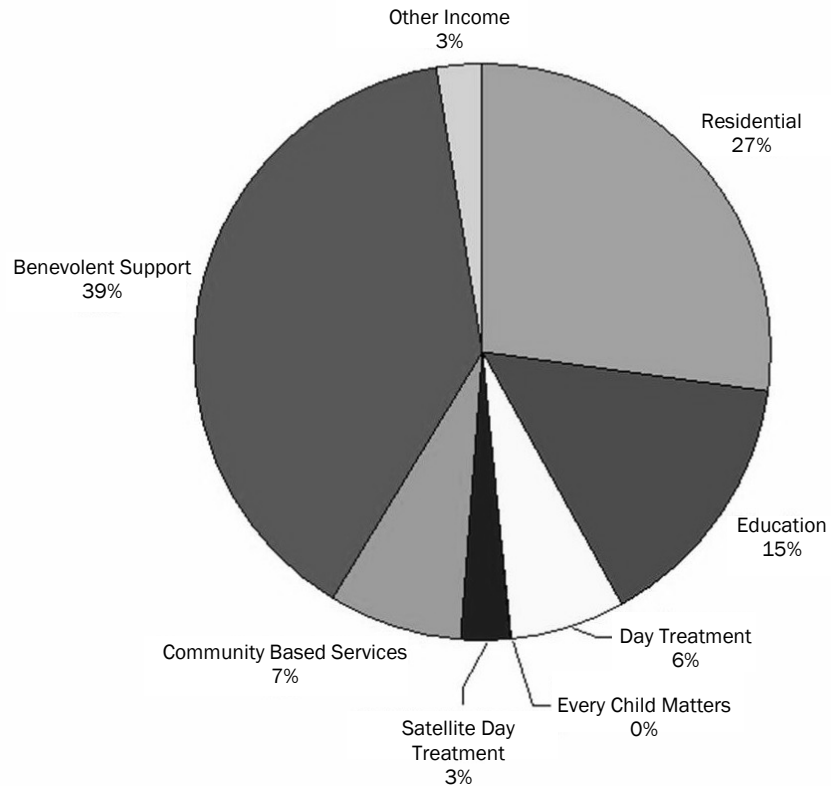

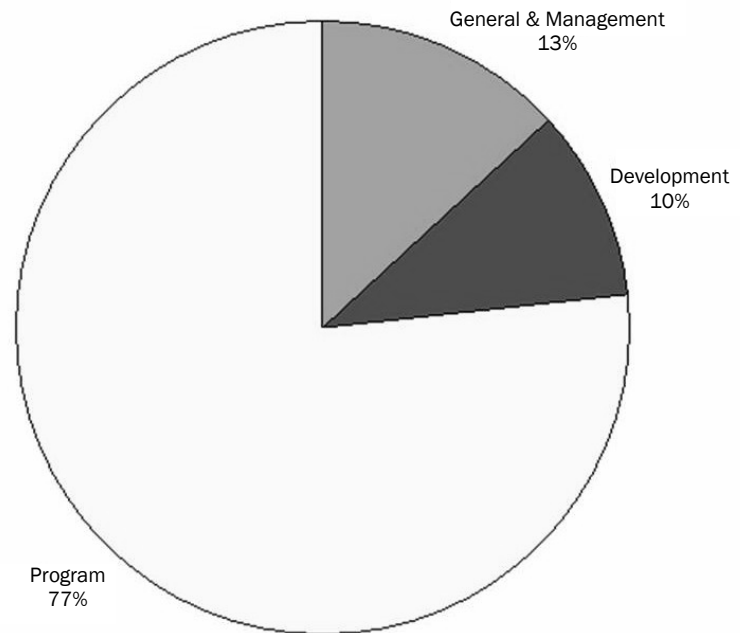
